

BELLS PARADE DEVELOPMENT PLAN IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE

DRAFT TERMS OF REFERENCE

Background

The Bells Parade Development Plan is a 10-year plan for the future development of the Bells Parade Precinct from the Miles Ford Bridge through to the Anglers Access (below the Latrobe Sewage Treatment Plant) and to River Road to the north and the Mersey River, inclusive of Pig Island, to the south.

Key stakeholders involved in this process included Latrobe Works, Latrobe Council, Latrobe Landcare Group Inc, Australian Axemans Hall of Fame, representation from the Henley-on-the-Mersey Management Committee, Lions Club of Latrobe, LMIRG Tourism Sub-committee, Sherwood Hall and the National Trust.

The draft plan went to the July 9th 2007 meeting of Council and was subsequently adopted at that meeting.

Committee Roles and Responsibilities

The Bells Parade Development Plan Implementation Committee has been established to consider and make recommendations to Latrobe Council on matters relating to the Bells Parade Development Plan such as:

- Recommendation, prioritization and implementation of projects
- Allocation of funding (e.g. disbursement of proceeds from Henley on the Mersey)
- Consideration of other projects in relation to the Bells Parade Precinct

Representation on the Bells Parade Development Plan Committee, to ensure maximum networking and enable a comprehensive discussion of topics at meetings, is as follows:-

- Latrobe Council – 1 Elected Member
- Lions Club of Latrobe – 1 Representative
- Rotary Club of Latrobe – 1 Representative
- Australian Axeman's Hall of Fame – 1 Representative
- Latrobe Landcare – 1 Representative
- Latrobe Council – Executive Support

Bells Parade Development Committee meetings will initially be held bi-monthly on a Tuesday commencing at 7.00pm at the Latrobe Council Chambers.

The Bells Parade Development Plan Implementation Committee has an advisory role only. After due consideration, the Committee provides recommendations to Council. Council then determines whether it supports or rejects the recommendation provided by the Committee and actions the recommendations accordingly.

Representation on this committee is voluntary.
