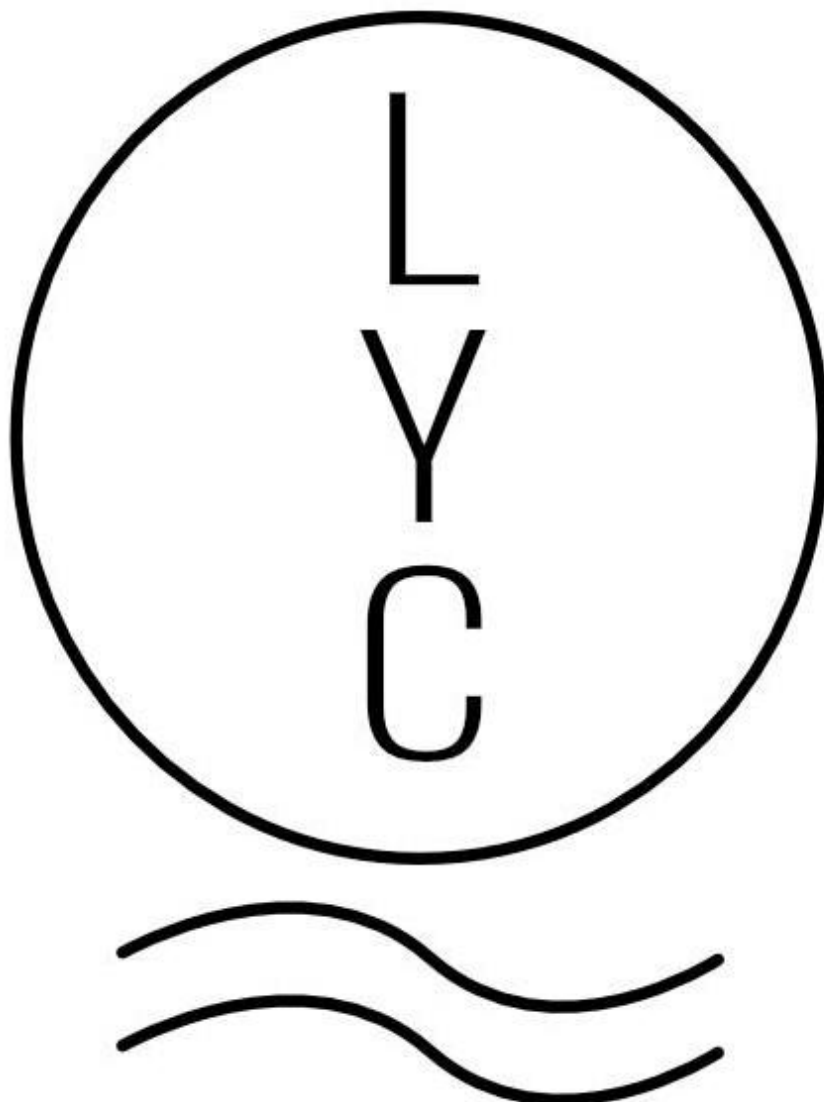

Latrobe Council is looking for energetic, self-motivated people aged between 16 and 30 years and who live in the Latrobe Municipality to join the Latrobe Youth Council (LYC).

Formed in 2017 as a Special Committee under Section 24 of the *Local Government Act 1993*, LYC was established as the primary reference point for Latrobe Council on issues and needs relating to young people.

In February 2018, the age criteria was extended to 30 years of age (previously 25 years) to further diversify membership and, consequently, points of view.

LYC objectives are:

1. To consult with young people, and determine the needs and issues relating to them in the Latrobe Municipality.
2. To represent the identified needs, issues, views of young people to the Latrobe Council.
3. To work with the Latrobe Council to identify strategies to respond to the needs, and issues related to young people in the Municipality.
4. To work with Latrobe Council to facilitate and develop opportunities for young people in the Municipality to participate in the community and in Council consultation and decision-making processes.
5. To contribute to the development of a positive profile and image of young people in the community.
6. To identify personal development and leadership development opportunities for Latrobe Youth Council members.
7. To represent young people in other forums outside Council and outside the Latrobe Municipality.
8. To inform and advise Council, and act as a reference and consultation point for Council programs and activities, where appropriate.
9. To provide information and advice to other communities developing processes of youth participation.

LYC gets together a minimum of once a month, current a Tuesday, from 6.00pm at the Latrobe Council Chambers, 170 Gilbert Street, Latrobe with successful nominees required to commit their involvement for a minimum of two-years.
